## Activity 11: How well did we do?

### Learning Objective

To enable pupils to review the success of their enterprise activity.

### Entrepreneurship Characteristics

### Learning activities

Discuss with the pupils the outcomes of their enterprise project.

- “How successful were we?”
- “How many products have we sold?”
- “How much profit did we make?”

- “What did we enjoy?”
- “What would we change/improve for next time?”

Opportunity for peer comment/assessment.
