## Activity 3a: Who shall we speak to?

### Learning Objective

To enable pupils to prepare for a visit to school by a representative from a local enterprise/business.

### Entrepreneurship Characteristics

#### Creativity

- Communication

#### Organisation

- Planning

### Learning activities

Discuss the pupils' ideas for an enterprise project generated in Activity 2.

Pose the question *"Who could we ask to find out more about our ideas?"*

Invite a representative from a local enterprise to visit the school. The visitor could represent a business providing a similar product or service or be a charity or organisation that the enterprise will raise money for.

Pupils prepare questions they plan to ask the visitor e.g. *"What do you do?" "What do you make?" "How do you do it?"*

Pupils plan who will ask the questions and who will be responsible for meeting the visitor.
